ORDER

This Criminal Original Petition has been filed to quash the proceedings in C.C.No.362 of 2023, on the file of the District Munsif cum Judicial Magistrate Court, Vedaranyam, Nagapattinam District.

2. The case is still in the stage of trial. By passage of time, the parties have decided to bury their hatchet and compromise the dispute amicably among themselves.

3. Joint compromise memo dated 28.11.2023, has been filed before this Court which has been signed by the petitioners and the 2nd respondent/de facto complainant and also by their respective counsel. The petitioners and the second respondent were also present in person before this Court and they were identified by M.Panneerselvam, SI of Police, Vettaikaranyeruppu Police Station. In the affidavit, it has been stated that the petitioners and the second respondent have entered into a compromise and amicably settled their issues in C.C.No.362 of 2023, on the file of the District Munsif cum Judicial Magistrate Court, Vedaranyam, Nagapattinam District.

4. Under such circumstances, no useful purpose will be served in keeping the case pending, even though, the offences involved are not compoundable in nature. In the light of the guidelines given by the Hon'ble Supreme Court reported in **2017 9 SCC 641- (Parbathbhai Aahir @ Parbathbhai Vs. State of Gujrat)**, this Court in exercise of its jurisdiction under Section 482 Cr.P.C., to quash the proceedings in C.C.No.362 of 2023, on



the file of the District Munsif cum Judicial Magistrate Court, Vedaranyam, Nagapattinam District.

5. This Criminal Original Petition stands allowed and as a sequel, the proceedings in C.C.No.362 of 2023, on the file of the District Munsif cum Judicial Magistrate Court, Vedaranyam, Nagapattinam District, is hereby quashed in entirety and the terms of Joint Compromise Memo shall form part and parcel of this order. Each of the petitioner shall pay a sum of Rs.750-/ (Rupees seven hundred and fifty only) as costs, to the credit of the **President, Tamil Nadu Advocate's Clerk Association, Madras High Court, Chennai (Indian Bank, High Court Branch, A/c No.484026006, IFSC Code:IDIB000M157)**, within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order and file a photocopy of the receipt along with a memo reporting compliance in the Registry. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition is closed.

6. Post this case for reporting compliance on **16.02.2024**.
