This petition has been filed to condone the delay of 8 days in filing the above criminal appeal.

2.Mr.C.E.Pratap, learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) takes notice for the 2nd respondent police and he has got no objection in allowing this petition.

3.The learned counsel for the 1st respondent/estranged husband of the defacto complainant submitted that already, he filed appeal in C.A.No.804 of 2023 before this Court against the conviction in S.C.No.8 of 2021, dated 28.06.2023.
