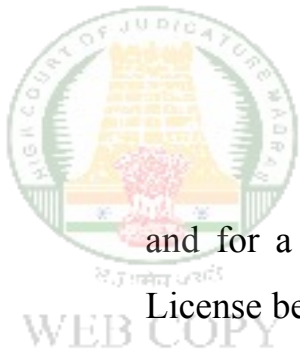

ORDER
