



CrI.O.P.No.30053 of 2024

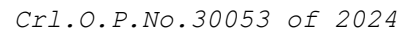

Apprehending arrest in connection with Crime No.226 of 2024 registered for the offences punishable under Section 74 of BNSS, 2023 and Section 4 of TN Prohibition and Harassment of Women Act, 2002, the present petition has been filed seeking anticipatory bail.

2.Pleading innocence on the part of the petitioner, false implication in the case, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks indulgence of this court. He also submits that the petitioner is an innocent person. He also submits that the petitioner is ready to abide by any stringent condition that may be imposed by this court.

3.The case of the prosecution as putforth by the learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) appearing for the respondent police, opposing for grant of anticipatory bail, is that on 29.08.2024, the petitioner boarded the ladies compartment of a Metro train, traveling from Koyambedu to Nandanam, when the de facto complainant asked him to move to the general compartment, he refused to do so and attacked her.



[e] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate



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action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560]**;

[f] If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 269 of BNS.
