ORDER

Petition seeking bail in respect of Crime No.310 of 2024 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 310(2) and 311 of BNS is on board for consideration.



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2. The incarceration of the petitioner being from 04.11.2024 pleading innocence on the part of the petitioner and false implication in the case, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks indulgence of this Court. He also submits that the petitioner, aged about 19 years, is no way connected with the alleged offence, however, he has been implicated in this case only based on the suspicion. He further submits that even as per the prosecution, the petitioner is said to have stood outside the de facto complainant's house and he has not committed any offence. He also submits that the petitioner is ready to abide by any stringent condition that may be imposed by this court.

3. The case of the prosecution as putforth by the learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) appearing for the respondent police, opposing for grant of bail, is that the accused had entered into the house of the de facto complainant, and by threatening and assaulting the de facto complainant and his friends, robbed their mobile phones, laptop and a cash of Rs.17,500/- from them. He also submits that the investigation in this case is still pending and only part of the stolen articles were recovered. He further submits that there are seven accused in this case and there is no previous case against the petitioner/A6 herein.



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4. Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) for the respondent Police and perused the materials available on record, and taking note of the specific overtact against the petitioner and also considering that there is no previous case against the petitioner, this court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner with certain conditions and accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his executing a bond for a sum of **Rs.15,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Thousand only)** with **two sureties**, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned **Judicial Magistrate No.I, Coimbatore**, and on further conditions that:

[a] the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity;

[b] the petitioner shall report before the respondent Police, everyday at 06.30 p.m., until further orders;

[c] the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial;

[d] the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial;

[e] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate



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action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in ***P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560]***;

[f] If the accused thereafter abscond, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 269 of B.N.S.
