The petitioner is the father of the detenu viz., Nandha @ Veera Tamizhan, S/o.Madhanagopal, aged 28 years, detained at the Superintendent, Central Prison, Tiruchirappalli, has come forward with this petition challenging the detention order passed by the second respondent dated 30.11.2023 slapped on his son, branding him as "Goonda" under the Tamil Nadu Prevention of Dangerous Activities of Bootleggers, Drug Offenders, Forest Offenders, Goondas, Immoral Traffic Offenders, Sand Offenders, Slum Grabbers and Video Pirates Act, 1982 [Tamil Nadu Act, 14 of 1982].
