



Crl.O.P.No.30441 of 2024

Apprehending arrest in connection with Crime No.152 of 2024 registered for the offence punishable under Section 379 of IPC, the present petition has been filed seeking anticipatory bail.

2.Pleading innocence on the part of the petitioner, false implication in the case, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks indulgence of this Court. Learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner is innocent and that a case of Two Wheeler theft has been fabricated against him. He further submits that the petitioner is ready to abide by any stringent condition that may be imposed by this Court.

3.The case of the prosecution as putforth by the learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) appearing for the respondent Police, opposing for grant of anticipatory bail, is that he had committed theft on the complainant's two wheeler bearing Registered No.TN-39-CT-2194. He further submitted that, apart from this case, petitioner has seven previous cases of similar in nature



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pending against the petitioner and therefore, the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is very much required.

4. Considering the gravity of the offence committed by the petitioner and also the fact that the petitioner has got seven previous cases which are similar in nature pending against him, this Court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

5. Accordingly, this Criminal Original petition is dismissed.
