This case came up for settlement before the National Lok Adalat. Both the parties are present. The learned counsel for the appellant, Mr.M.Pachaiyappan and the learned counsel for the 2nd respondent Mr.J.Michael Visuvasam are present. After mutual discussion, negotiation, mediation and conciliation between both parties, they arrived at a compromise to settle the matter as



follows:

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TERMS OF SETTLEMENT

Both the parties and their respective counsel are present.

2.The instant appeal has been preferred by the claimant seeking enhancement of the compensation awarded by the Tribunal. The Tribunal awarded a compensation of Rs.19,14,200/- @ 7.5.% p.a.

3.Parties have now agreed for a settlement, by which the 2nd respondent/Insurance Company has agreed to pay an additional sum of Rs.17,50,000/- (Rupees Seventeen Lakhs Fifty Thousand only) in full quit less the amount already deposited to the claimant, within a period of eight (8) weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. On such deposit, the claimant shall be entitled to withdraw the said amount.

4.The Tribunal is directed to follow the usual mode of payment on proper identification of the parties, concerned, in accordance with the terms of the award, without insisting on any formal permission petition. The Civil Miscellaneous Appeal is ordered accordingly.
