ORDER

Petition seeking bail in respect of Crime No.688 of 2024 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 296(b), 118(1), 109 & 351(3) of BNS, is on board for consideration.



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2. The incarceration of the petitioner being from 10.12.2024 pleading innocence on the part of the petitioner and false implication in the case, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks indulgence of this Court. He further submits that the petitioner is in no way connected with the alleged offence and due to previous enmity, a false compliant has been lodged against the petitioner. He also submits that even as per the prosecution, the injured has been discharged from the hospital and the petitioner is ready to abide by any stringent condition that may be imposed by this Court.

3. The case of the prosecution as putforth by the learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) appearing for the respondent police, opposing for grant of bail, is that due to previous enmity, the accused abused the de facto complainant in filthy language and attempted to murder her by assaulting her with a knife and escaped from the scene of occurrence. He further submits that the injured has been discharged from the hospital, the investigation in this case is still pending and further, there is no previous case against the petitioner.

4. Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) for the respondent Police and perused the



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materials available on record and considering that there is no previous case against the petitioner, this court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner with certain conditions and accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his executing a bond for a sum of **Rs.15,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Thousand only)** with **two sureties**, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned **X Metropolitan Magistrate, Egmore**, and on further conditions that:

[a] the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity;

[b] **the petitioner shall stay at Chengalpattu and report before the Inspector of Police, Chengalpattu Town Police Station, everyday at 10.30 a.m., until further orders. It is made clear that the petitioner shall not enter into the jurisdictional limits of the respondent Police, until further orders;**

[c] the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial;

[d] the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial;

[e] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme
