COMMON ORDER

These writ petitions are filed to call for the records of the 2nd respondent in No.Nil dated 15.03.2018 and quash the same and consequently direct the respondents to pay the attendant, monetary benefits and back wages for the period the petitioners were out of service by treating the period from 15.03.2018 to the actual date of reinstatement as on duty.

2.Though the writ petitions are filed for a writ of Certiorarified Mandamus to quash the order dated 15.03.2018 of the second respondent and consequently direct the respondents to pay the attendant, monetary benefits and back wages for the period the petitioners were out of service, the learned counsel for the petitioners at the time of arguments restricted the prayer for a direction to the respondents to consider the representation of the petitioners

dated 20.04.2018.
