PRAYER: Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of Constitution of India, pleaded to issue a Writ of Mandamus calling for the records of the second respondent relating to Na.Ka.No.A2/75407/10 dated 20.06.2011 and Ref.No.A2/29007/2011 dated 16.08.2011, quash the same and for consequential direction to the first respondent to count petitioner's service from the date of getting special grade or to relax the adhoc rule of Tamil Nadu Forest Service Rule 4(2), in which the qualifying service is fixed as 8



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years for promotion to the post of Assistant Conservator of forest for 3 years for those who have completed 25 years of service in the Forester Cadre.
