Prayer in W.P.(MD)No.349 of 2024 : Writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, to issue a Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondents to issue permanent registration certificate on the roll of the Register of registered medical practitioners manual by the fourth respondent forthwith as the petitioner has completed one year compulsory rotating medical internship on 04.12.2023 in Virudhunagar Government Medical College and Hospital with effect from 05.12.2022 with all consequential benefits and arrears of stipend of Rs.25,750/- per month from 05.12.2022 up to the period of internship with interest and cost.
