PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL UNDER SEC 438 OF CR.P.C.

PRAYER : FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL IN CRIME NO.2/2024 ON THE FILE OF THE
RESPONDENT POLICE.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner / Accused No.1, who apprehends arrest at the hands of the
respondent Police for the alleged offence punishable under Sections 294(b), 324 and
506(ii) of I.P.C. in Crime No.2 of 2024, on the file of the respondent Police, seeks
anticipatory bail.



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2. The case of the prosecution is that during the Temple festival, the petitioner and other accused persons attacked the defacto complainant, due to which, the defacto complainant sustained grievous injuries. Thereby, he made a complaint before the respondent Police and the respondent Police registered a case against the petitioner.

3. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner has not committed any such offence as alleged by the prosecution. He would further submit that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case. Hence, he prays for anticipatory bail.

4. The learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) appearing for the respondent Police would submit that Accused Nos.2 and 3 were arrested and remanded to judicial custody. He would further submit that three previous cases are pending against the petitioner and all are similar in nature. He would further submit that if anticipatory bail is granted to the petitioner herein, it would create trouble in the locality. Hence, he vehemently opposes for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner herein,

5. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and also considering the fact that three previous cases which are pending against the petitioner are similar in nature, this Court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner herein.



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6. Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition stands dismissed.
