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Prayer in CrI.A.(MD).No.916 of 2023:

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This Criminal Appeal is filed under Section 14(A)(2) of SC/ST (POA) Act, 1989 as Amended by Act 1 of 2015, to set aside the order of the learned Special Court for trial of SC/ST (POA) Act Cases, (FAC), Virudhunagar District at Srivilliputhur in Cr.M.P.No.3247 of 2023 dated 03.10.2023 and enlarge the petitioner/appellant/sole accused on bail in Crime No.303 of 2023 on the file of the first respondent police.
