“ This Criminal Miscellaneous Petition has been filed to relax the condition imposed on the petitioner in CrI.M.P. (MD).No.16384 of 2023 in CrI.A.(MD).No.927 of 2023 dated 23.11.2023.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that as per the direction of this Court, the petitioner is complying with the conditions regularly from 21.10.2023. He further submitted that due to the conditions imposed on the petitioner, he is not in a position to attend his work regularly, which affects his livelihood and hence, he pleaded for relaxing the condition imposed on him by the Court below.

3.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the State would submit that petitioner is complying with the conditions imposed by this Court regularly and hence, the conditions may be modified once in a month.
