“3.....Therefore, I sent complaint as against the Hon'ble Mr.Justice S.S.SUNDAR,J, now, I analysed my mistake and I submit unconditional apology before this Hon'ble Court for the act of lodged complaints dated 16.07.2023 & 22.07.2023 without substantiate materials. Hence, I request this Hon'ble Court may treat this affidavit as my apology and I withdraw my complaints and allegations stated in the complaints dated 16.07.2023 & 22.07.2023. Further, I undertake that I will not sent any complaint without substantiate materials in future as against the Hon'ble Judges and Judicial Officers....”

2.Accepting the said unconditional apology tendered by the respondent / party-in-person, this Contempt Petition is closed by warning the respondent that in future he should not make this kind of allegation against the Hon'ble Judges of this Court and the Judicial Officers without any substantiate materials and if any



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such allegation is made without substantiate materials in future, it will be viewed seriously and no lenient view will be taken by this Court.
