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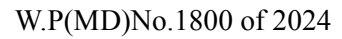

ORDER

This writ petition is filed seeking for issuance of a Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus to call for the records pertaining to the public auction notice issued by the respondent vide his proceeding in Na.Ka.No. 1123/2023/A3 dated 02.01.2024 and quash the part of the same insofar as the auction of two wheeler parking lot at the Karnal John Pennycuick Bus Stand Ground Floor Main Block (North), Theni is concerned as illegal and further to direct the respondent to extend the lease given to the petitioner by the respondent vide his proceeding in Na.Ka.No.1146/2020/A3 dated 12.02.2021 to run the two Wheeler parking lot at the Karnal John Pennycuick Bus Stand Ground Floor Main Block (North), Theni, for a further period of one year.

2. Heard Mr.A.Jayaramachandran, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr.G.Kaleeswaran, learned Standing Counsel appearing for the respondent. By consent, this Writ Petition itself is taken up for final disposal.

In view of the above, without going into the merits of the claim made by the petitioner in this Writ Petition, the respondent is directed to pass appropriate orders on the representation of the petitioner, dated 24.01.2024, on merits and in accordance with law, after giving notice to the interested parties, if any, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.



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6. With the above directions, this writ petition is disposed of. No costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petitions are closed.
