Prayer in WP(MD). 19997/ 2013 :

To issue a Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus to call for the records from the 1st respondent relating to the proceedings NO.P13/21305073/3/PPO.NO.F1305073 datd 8.5.2013 and quash the same as illegal and consequently direct the 1st respondent to pay the family pension and retirement benefits to the petitioner from march 2011 onwards with all attendant monetary benefits.
