Prayer :-

Criminal Revision Petition filed under Section 397 r/w 401 of Cr.P.C., to call for the entire records pertaining to the Judgment dt.16.9.2022 passed by the III Additional District Judge, Thanjavur at Pattukottai in CA.No.44 of 2021 confirming the Judgment dt.20.3.2020 passed by the FTC(Magisterial Level), Pattukottai, Thanjavur District in S.T.C.No.89 of 2019 and set aside the same.

ORDER:- This Petition coming on for hearing on this day under the caption 'Extension of time for 'Lower Court' and upon perusing earlier order dated 02.08.2024 and the requisition submitted by the III Additional District



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Judge, Thanjavur at Pattukottai in D.No.26/2025 dated 06.01.2025 seeking further
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three months time to dispose of the case in C.A.No.44/2021, this Court made the
following Order:

2. It is seen from the records that this Court vide order dated 02.08.2024
directed the appellate Court to dispose of the appeal within a period of two months
from the date of receipt of a copy of that order.

3. The learned III Additional District Judge, Thanjavur @ Pattukkottai,
has submitted a requisition dated 06.01.2025 stating that the appeal could not be
disposed of as the appellant was not co-operating to proceed with the appeal.

4. When the matter is taken up today, the learned counsel for the
petitioner would submit that he is not having any instructions.

5. The learned counsel for the respondent would submit that the
respondent is ready to proceed with the appeal, but the petitioner alone has been
dragging the matter.

6. Considering the above, the learned Appellate Judge is directed to hear
the appeal and dispose of the same within a period of one month from the date of
receipt of a copy of this order and in case, if the revision petitioner / appellant again



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is not represented by her Counsel, or is adopting dilatory tactics, the learned
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Appellate Judge is directed to follow the dictum laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme
Court in Bani Singh and others Vs. State Of U.P, reported in AIR 1996 SC 2439.
