2.Heard Mr.D.Rajaboopathy, learned Counsel appearing for the petitioner and Mr.F.Deepak, learned Counsel for the respondent.

3.The petitioner has preferred a complaint before the Human Rights Commission on 04.02.2022, which was registered in Dairy No.2420/CR/2022 and the same is pending before the respondent Commission. Since the said complaint remains unattended by the respondent till date, the petitioner has preferred the present Writ Petition.

4.The said complaint has been taken on file and the same is pending according to the petitioner. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the nature of the complaint, this

Court cannot pass a specific direction to the respondent to pass orders on the said complaint within a stipulated time.
