Prayer in WP(MD). 21749/ 2017 :

To issue a writ of Certiorarified Mandamus to call for the records pertaining to the impugned order passed by the 3rd respondent in Na.Ka.No.A 2/44901/2015 dated 24.12.2015 and further direct him to fix the petitioners service period commencing from 09.06.1993 and to give promotion and other benefits for the same.
