ORDER

3. Learned Senior Counsel for the petitioner fairly agrees that the petitioner will submit a copy of the application to the authority concerned once again.

On such filing of application, the 2nd respondent/District Collector shall consider the same and pass orders in accordance with law, within a period of four weeks thereafter.

5. With the above directions, this review application is disposed of. It is made clear that except fixing the above time limit, the order dated 07.02.2024 passed in Sub.A.(MD)No.28 of 2024 in Cont.P.(MD)No.1671 of 2018 stands unaltered. No costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition is closed.
