ORDER

The learned Government Advocate would state that the third respondent has filed a civil suit in the meanwhile. The first respondent is directed to hear the petitioner as well as the third respondent and pass final order on merits and in accordance with law within a period of eight weeks from the date receipt of a copy of this order. I make it clear that I have not gone into the merits of the matter.

3.This writ petition is disposed of accordingly. No costs.
