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Order : This Criminal Miscellaneous Petition coming up for orders on this day, upon perusing the petition filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of MR.G.KARUPPASAMY PANDIYAN, Advocate for the petitioner and of MR.M.MUTHUMANIKKAM, Government Advocate (Criminal Side) on behalf of the Respondent, the Court made the following order:-

This Criminal Miscellaneous Petition has been filed to relax the condition imposed on the petitioner in Crl.M.P.(MD) No.17341 of 2023 in Crl.A(MD) No.319 of 2023 dated 12.01.2023.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that as per the direction of this Court, the petitioner is complying with the conditions regularly from 06.02.2024 and hence, he pleaded for relaxing the condition imposed on him by this Court.

3.The learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) appearing for the respondent would submit that the petitioner is complying with the conditions imposed by this Court regularly and hence, the conditions may be modified once in a month.



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4. Considering the submissions made on either side, the condition imposed on the petitioner is modified to the effect that the petitioner shall report before the concerned trial Court, once in a month at 10.30 a.m., until further orders.
