PETITION FOR BAIL Under Sec.439 of Cr.P.C.

PRAYER :-

For Bail in Crime No.6/2024 on the file of the respondent police.



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ORDER: The Court made the following order :-

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The petitioner, who was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 03.01.2024 for the offence punishable under Sections 294(b), 448, 324 and 307 IPC, in Crime No.6 of 2024 on the file of the respondent Police, seeks bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that due to previous enmity, the petitioner entered into the defacto complainant's house and abused him in filthy language and attacked him and his wife with Aruval. Hence, the complaint.

3. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner is an innocent person and he has not committed any such offence as alleged by the prosecution. He would further submit that the petitioner is in judicial custody from 03.01.2024. Hence, he prays for bail.

4. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent would submit that the injured was discharged from the hospital.

5. Heard the learned counsel on either side.

6. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the period of incarceration suffered by the petitioner and the fact that the injured was discharged from the hospital, this court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner, subject to the following conditions:

7. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his



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executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate, Thiruvaiyar, and on further conditions that:

(a) the sureties shall affix their photographs and left thumb impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity;

(b) the petitioner is directed to appear before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m., for a period of two weeks and thereafter, as and when required for interrogation;

(c) the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial;

(d) the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial;

(e) on breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/ Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji Vs. State of Kerala [(2005) AIR SCW 5560]; and;



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(f)if the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 229-A IPC.
