Therefore, recording the terms as per the Mediated Settlement Agreement dated 20.06.2024, this Transfer Civil Miscellaneous Petition is ordered by recording that the transfer of H.M.O.P. No.150 of 2023 is unnecessary as the parties are going to file a mutual divorce petition afresh. The concerned Family Court shall take into consideration of the fact that the matter was pending and thereafter settled in the mediation, while considering the question of waiving the cooling period.
