PETITION FOR BAIL Under Sec.439 of Cr.P.C.

PRAYER :-

For Bail in Crime No.176 of 2024 on the file of the respondent police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner/Accused, who was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 14.03.2024 for the offences punishable under Sections 294(b) IPC r/w 25(1A) of



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Arms Act in Crime No.176 of 2024, on the file of the respondent police, seeks bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that the defacto complainant's husband died on 13.03.2024. Due to land dispute between the petitioner and the defacto complainant, on 14.03.2024, the petitioner came in front of the defacto complainant's house, scolded her in filthy language and threatened her showing deadly weapon. Hence, the complaint.

3.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner did not commit any allegations as alleged by the prosecution. He would further submit that the petitioner is in judicial custody from 14.03.2024. Hence, he prays for grant bail to the petitioner.

4.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent would submit that there is no one injured in this case. Hence, he has no objection to grant bail to the petitioner.

5.Heard. Perused the materials available on record including the First Information Report.

6.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and there is no one person injured in this case, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner with certain conditions.

7.Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is ordered and the petitioner is



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ordered to be released on bail on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate No.II, Kumbakonam, and on further conditions that:

(a) the sureties shall affix their photographs and left thumb impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity;

(b) the petitioner is directed to appear before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m., until further orders;

(c) the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial;

(d) the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial;

(e) on breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/ Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji Vs. State of Kerala [(2005) AIR SCW 5560]; and;



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(f)if the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 229-A IPC.
