PRAYER: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying for a Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondents to stop all the buses which are plying under the control of respondents 3 and 4 for tacking up and setting down passengers at Chithamparaburam bus stop and Kalugachalpuram bus stop and subsequently direct the respondents 1 and 2 to erect a sign board in Sign No.M.36 (Compulsory bus stop) of mandatory signs of scheduled of Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 and consequently direct the respondents to monitor that the buses are halt at Chithamparaburam and Kalugachalpuram village bus stops based on the proceedings of the fourth respondent issued in LR.No.UTM-TCN/AM(COM)/TNSTC/TNV/2021 dated 11.09.2023.
