Prayer : Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court to issue a Writ of Mandamus, directing the 3rd respondent to consider the representation dated 19.03.2024 and extend the protection order to complete his elegance to the ancestral deity “Mundasamy” situated at Kattarimangalam Village Sathankulam Taluk Thoothukudi District along with Village People and their relatives and to take immediate action against the respondents 6 to 9 for the illegal ex communication of the petitioner and his family members from the village by considering the petitioner's representation.

ORDER

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner, the learned Additional Government Pleader appearing for the respondents 1 to 3 and the learned counsel appearing for the respondents 6 to 9.

2. The petitioner had earlier filed W.P.(MD).No.6309 of 2024. When the matter was taken up for hearing, the parties informed the Court that peace committee meeting will be held on 17.03.2024 to resolve the issues and the said



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Writ Petition was disposed of. On 16.03.2024, peace committee meeting was conducted and certain decisions were arrived at. Now, the festival is to be held on 29.03.2024. The petitioner undertakes to pay a sum of Rs.6000/-. The eighth respondent is directed to receive the same and also issue receipt. As regards the liability to pay the past arrears, the issue is left open.

3. The learned counsel for the respondents 6 to 9 informs the Court that the petitioner can observe the usual functions and it will not be prevented.

4. Recording the stand of the private respondents, the Writ Petition is disposed of. There shall be no order as to costs.
