PRAYER :- For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.70/2024 on the file of the Respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner, apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent Police, in connection with a case in Crime No.70 of 2024, for the offence punishable under

Sections 294(b), 448, 323, 506 (i) I.P.C and Section 4 of Tamil Nadu Prevention of



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Harassment of Women Act, 2002, has filed this petition seeking anticipatory bail.

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2. The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner and the defacto complainant are husband and wife. Due to matrimonial dispute, the petitioners have abused the defacto complainant in filthy language and also assaulted her and her parents. Hence, the case.

3. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is an innocent person and he has not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution. Hence, he prays for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

4. The learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) appearing for the respondent Police submits that the allegation as against the petitioner is that the petitioner is the husband of the defacto complainant and they are having difference of opinion and living separately. The defacto complainant has filed a divorce petition and got divorce. Even then, the petitioner went to the place of the defacto complainant, assaulted the defacto complainant and her parents and also attempted to take away the child. He further submits that the injured has been discharged from the hospital.



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5. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and also considering the fact that the petitioner shall work out his remedy by filing Guardian O.P and on the assurance given by the petitioner that he will not interfere with the defacto complainant and his parents and that the injured has been discharged from the hospital, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

6. Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is ordered and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of his arrest or on their appearance within a period of fifteen days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, before the learned Judicial Magistrate on condition that

(i) the petitioner execute a bond for a sum of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) each, with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate No.II, Sattur, Virudhunagar District.

(ii) The petitioner and the sureties shall submit a copy of their Aadhaar Card or any other identity card issued by the government in proof of their residence address;

(iii) The petitioner shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. He has to co-operate for the



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investigation.

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(iv) The petitioner shall not misuse the liberty granted to him by indulging in any further offence and shall not tamper with the prosecution witnesses.

(v) On violation of any of the above conditions by the petitioner, the respondent police shall move an application for cancellation of the anticipatory bail.
