PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :- For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.23 of 2024 on the file of the Respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner, who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offence punishable under Sections 294(b), 324 & 506(ii) IPC in Crime No.23 of 2024 on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that the parties herein are neighbours. On 24.02.2024, on the eve of floating festival, at about 10.30 pm., the accused persons blocked the road by putting up stones and wooden logs. When the same was questioned by the defacto complainant's son, A1 abused him in filthy language and poured hot milk on him and also threatened him with dire consequences.

3.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has not indulged in such criminal activities. However, the respondent police has falsely implicated the petitioner in this case.

4.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the respondent submits that the injured person has already been discharged from the hospital.

5.Considering the facts and circumstances of this case and also considering that the injured person has already been discharged from the hospital, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

6.Accordingly, this criminal original petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance, within a period of fifteen days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Thiruppathur on condition that the petitioner shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate,

Thiruppathur and on further conditions that:

- i. The petitioner and the sureties shall submit a copy of their Aadhaar Card or any other identity card issued by the Government in proof of their residence address;
- ii. The petitioner shall appear before the respondent police daily at 10.30 am for a period of one week, and thereafter as and when required. He has to co-operate for the investigation.
- iii. The petitioner shall not misuse the liberty granted to him by indulging in any further offence and shall not tamper with the prosecution witnesses. The petitioner shall be available for the trial as well.
- iv. On violation of any of the above conditions by the petitioner, the respondent police shall move an application for cancellation of the anticipatory bail.
