PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No. 81 of 2024 on the file of the respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioners, who apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offence punishable under Sections 294(b), 324 of IPC and Section 4 of Tamil Nadu Prohibition of Harassment of Women Act, seek anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that the petitioners and the defacto complainant are neighbours and there is a dispute among them in grazing their cattle in their



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respective lands, due to which, the petitioners have assaulted the defacto complainant.

3.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have not indulged in any offence as alleged by the prosecution. It is a case and counter case. The first petitioner has sustained severe injuries and he is undergoing treatment.

4.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the respondent submits that it is a case and counter case in Crime No.82 of 2024. The injured has been discharged from the Hospital on 18.03.2024.

5.Considering the nature of allegations and considering the fact that the injured has been discharged from the Hospital, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

6.Accordingly, this criminal original petition is allowed and the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance, within a period of fifteen days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Athoor, Dindigul on condition that the petitioners shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate, Athoor, Dindigul and on further conditions that:



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- i. The petitioners and the sureties shall submit a copy of their Aadhaar Card or any other identity card issued by the Government in proof of their residence address;
- ii. The petitioners shall appear before the respondent police daily at 10.30 am for a period of fifteen days and thereafter shall appear as and when required. They have to co-operate for the investigation.
- iii. The petitioners shall not misuse the liberty granted to them by indulging in any further offence and shall not tamper with the prosecution witnesses. The petitioners shall be available for the trial as well.
- iv. On violation of any of the above conditions by the petitioners, the respondent police shall move an application for cancellation of the anticipatory bail.
