2.It is seen from the records that this Court, on 01.07.2024, taking note of the submission made on either side, had directed the respondent Police to take appropriate steps to proceed with the investigation in a proper manner and the concerned Deputy Superintendent of Police was directed to monitor the investigation of this case.

3.When the matter is taken up for hearing today, the learned Government Advocate(Crl.side) would submit that after investigation, they have already altered the case for the offence under Section 306 IPC against four persons including juvenile and the investigation is pending.
