The writ petition was allowed by directing the petitioner to file a petition under Section 205 of Cr.P.C within a period of three days. It appears that the petitioner failed to file the petition within the time stipulated by this Court. The said delay is condoned. The petitioner is permitted to re-present the petition. It shall be re-presented on 23.04.2024. The learned trial Magistrate shall entertain the same
