PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C.

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.101 of 2024 on the file of the Respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner, apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent Police, in connection with a case in Crime No.101 of 2024, for the offence punishable under Sections 294(b), 323, 324, and 506(i) of IPC, has filed this petition seeking anticipatory bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner and the defacto complainant are from same village. Due to previous enmity between the petitioner and the defacto complainant, the petitioner has attacked the defacto complainant and also threatened to kill him. The de-facto complainant sustained injury. Hence, the case.

3. The learned Counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that it is a case and counter case. The de-facto complainant is said to have attacked the petitioner with knife and he sustained blood injury. Also, the learned Counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner has not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution. Hence, he prays for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

4. The learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) appearing for the respondent

Police submits that the petitioner has one previous case pending against him.

5. Considering that it is a case and counter case and also considering the antecedent of the petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

6. Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is ordered and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of their arrest or on their appearance within a period of fifteen days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, before the learned Judicial Magistrate on condition that

(i) the petitioner execute a bond for a sum of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) each, with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned District Munsif cum Judicial Magistrate, Aravakurichi, Karur.

(ii) The petitioner and the sureties shall submit a copy of their Aadhaar Card or any other identity card issued by the government in proof of their residence address;

(iii) The petitioner shall report before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m until further orders. He has to co-operate for the investigation

(iv) The petitioner shall not misuse the liberty granted to him by

indulging in any further offence and shall not tamper with the prosecution witnesses.

(v) On violation of any of the above conditions by the petitioner, the respondent police shall move an application for cancellation of the anticipatory bail.
