PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.153 of 2022 on the file of the Respondent Police.



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ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

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The petitioner, apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent Police, in connection with a case in Crime No.153 of 2022, for the offence punishable under Sections 417 and 420 IPC, has filed this petition seeking anticipatory bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the accused have promised the defacto complainant and others to get a job in Tamil Nadu Mercantile Bank and received Rs.11,00,000/-. But they failed to secure a job. Hence, the case.

3. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is also prepared to produce valuable security for grant of anticipatory bail. He further submits that the petitioner is an innocent person and he has not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution. Hence, he prays for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

4. The learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) appearing for the respondent Police submits that the first accused has cheated to the tune of Rs.85,00,000/- from fourteen persons and issued fake appointment orders.



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5. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and also considering the submission of the learned Counsel for the petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

6. Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is ordered and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of their arrest or on their appearance within a period of fifteen days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, before the learned Judicial Magistrate on condition that

(i) the petitioner shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand), with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate, Sathankulam.

(ii) The petitioner and the sureties shall submit a copy of their Aadhaar Card or any other identity card issued by the government in proof of their residence address;

(iii) The petitioner should deposit a sum of Rs.3,00,000/- to the credit of the Crime No.153 of 2022, on the file of the respondent police and should also produce the original deed of the property in Document No.1969 of 2021, before the trial Court.

(iv) The petitioner shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. He has to co-operate for the investigation. Further, the Petitioner has to appear before the trial Court in all the hearings without fail.



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(v) The petitioner shall not misuse the liberty granted to him by indulging in any further offence and shall not tamper with the prosecution witnesses.

(vi) On violation of any of the above conditions by the petitioner, the respondent police shall move an application for cancellation of the anticipatory bail.
