PETITION FOR BAIL Under Sec.439 of Cr.P.C.

PRAYER :- For Bail in Crime No. 85 of 2024 on the file of the respondent police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioners, who were arrested on 25.03.2024 for the alleged offence under Section 4(a) of Explosive Substances Act, subsequently altered into Section 4(a)

of Explosive Substances Act and Section 109, 438 of IPC in Crime No.85 of 2024, on

the file of the respondent police, seek bail.

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2.The case of the prosecution is that the defacto complainant has married the first petitioner's sister without the consent of their family members. Therefore, the petitioners had attempted to set fire on the Car, wherein, the defacto complainant and his wife were travelling, by throwing a polythene cover filled with petrol.

3.The learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the the petitioners have not involved in any such offence as alleged by the prosecution and due to some misunderstanding among the petitioners and the defacto complainant, a case has been registered. Now, the issue has been amicably settled.

4.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent submits that in the said occurrence, no one has been injured.

5. Considering the facts and circumstances of this case and the fact that no one has been injured in this case and also considering the period of incarceration, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioners.

6. Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is ordered and the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail on the following conditions:-

- i) The petitioners shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate, Shencottai,

Tenkasi.

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ii) The petitioners and the sureties shall submit a copy of their Aadhaar Card or any other identity card issued by the Government in proof of their residence address;

iii) The petitioners shall report before the Inspector of Police, Tallakulam Police Station, Madurai daily at 10.30 a.m., for a period of three weeks. The petitioners have to co-operate for the enquiry.

iv) The petitioners shall not misuse the liberty granted to them by indulging in any further offence and shall not tamper with the prosecution witnesses. The petitioners shall be available for the trial as well.

v) On violation of any of the above conditions by the petitioners, the respondent police shall move an application for cancellation of the bail.
