PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.92 of 2024 on the file of the respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner/A1, who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offence punishable under Sections 294(b), 323, 324 and 506(ii) of IPC in Crime No.92 of 2024 on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory

2.The case of the prosecution is that due to previous enmity between the parties, on 12.04.2024, the petitioner along with A2 picked up quarrel with the defacto complainant by using filthy language, attacked him with wooden log and also threatened him with dire consequences.

3.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has not indulged in any offence as alleged by the prosecution and he has been falsely implicated in this case.

4.The learned Government Advocate (Crl. side) for the respondent has strongly objected for grant of anticipatory bail on the ground that the investigation is yet to be completed. The injured person has been discharged from the hospital and no previous case is pending against the petitioner.

5.Considering the nature of offence, the antecedents of the petitioner and also considering the fact that the injured person has been discharged from the hospital, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

6.Accordingly, this criminal original petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance, within a period of fifteen days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, before the Judicial Magistrate Court, Thottiyam, Trichy District, on condition that the petitioner shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with

two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further conditions that:

- i. The petitioner and the sureties shall submit a copy of their Aadhaar Card or any other identity card issued by the Government in proof of their residence address;
- ii. The petitioner shall appear before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m., for a period of two weeks and thereafter, as and when required for interrogation. He has to co-operate for the investigation.
- iii. The petitioner shall not misuse the liberty granted to him by indulging in any further offence and shall not tamper with the prosecution witnesses. The petitioner shall be available for the trial as well.
- iv. On violation of any of the above conditions by the petitioner, the respondent police shall move an application for cancellation of the anticipatory bail.
