PETITION FOR BAIL Under Sec.439 of Cr.P.C.

PRAYER :-

For Bail in Crime No.483/2024 on the file of the respondent police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The respondent police registered a case as against this petitioner in Crime No.483 of 2024 for the offence under Sections 379 of IPC r/w 21(4) of Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulations) Act, 1957, and remanded him into judicial



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custody on 16.04.2024. Therefore, the petitioner has filed this petition seeking bail.

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2.The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner committed a theft of ½ unit of river sand.

3.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has not indulged in such criminal activities and he is languishing in jail for the past 11 days.

4.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the respondent opposes for grant of bail on the ground that the petitioner has one previous case to his credit and the investigation is yet to be completed.

5. Considering the nature of offence and also considering the period of incarceration, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

6. Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is ordered and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail

i) on the petitioner executing a bond for a sum of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the Judicial Magistrate Court, Papanasam, Thanjavur District.

ii) The petitioner and the sureties shall submit a copy of their Aadhaar Card or any other identity card issued by the Government in proof of their residence address;



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iii) The petitioner shall report before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m., for a period of two weeks and thereafter, as and when required for interrogation; He has to co-operate for the investigation;

iv) The petitioner shall not misuse the liberty granted to him by indulging in any further offence and shall not tamper with the prosecution witnesses. The petitioner shall be available for the trial as well.

v) On violation of any of the above conditions by the petitioner, the respondent police shall move an application for cancellation of the bail.
