PETITION FOR BAIL Under Sec.439 of Cr.P.C.

PRAYER :-

For Bail in Crime No.288 of 2024 on the file of the Respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner /sole accused, who was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 18.04.2024 for the offences under Sections 4(1)(a), 4(1-A) of Tamil Nadu Prohibition Act, in Crime No.288 of 2024 on the file of the respondent police, seeks



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2. The case of the prosecution is that on 16.04.2024, while the respondent police patrolling, the petitioner was found in possession of 48 numbers of 180 ml TASMAL brandy liquor bottles. Hence, the case.

3. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is an innocent person and he has not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution. However, he is languishing in jail from 18.04.2024. Hence, he prays for grant of bail to the petitioner.

4. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor opposes for grant of bail on the ground that the investigation is yet to be completed. He had further submitted that the petitioner is having two previous cases.

5. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and also taking note of the period of incarceration, this court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

6. Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is ordered and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of learned District Munsif Cum Judicial Magistrate, Thiruvudaimarudhur and on further conditions that :-

[a] the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass



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Book to ensure their identity.

[b] the petitioner shall report before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m., for a period of two weeks and thereafter as and when required for interrogation.

[c] the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial.

[d] the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial.

[e] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner is released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560].

[f] If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 229A IPC.
