PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Section 438 of Cr.P.C.

PRAYER :- For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.6 of 2024 on the file of the Respondent police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioners, who apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 420, 406, 468 & 471 of IPC in Crime No.6 of 2024,



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on the file of the respondent police, seek anticipatory bail.

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2.The case of the prosecution is that the petitioners have cheated the de-facto complainant under the guise of getting him a job in Singapore. Hence, the complaint.

3.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioners would submit that the petitioners are innocent and they have not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution.

4.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent police would submit that admittedly, the petitioners have cheated the de-facto complainant. He further submitted that the investigation is at initial stage and he prayed for dismissal of the anticipatory bail.

5.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioners would submit that the petitioners are ready and willing to deposit a sum of Rs.2,00,000/- (Rupees Two Lakhs Only).

6.Taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case and also recording the submission of the learned counsel for the petitioners, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners with certain conditions.

7.Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance, within a period of fifteen days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.I, Trichy, on



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condition that the petitioners shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) each with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further conditions that:

[a] the petitioners and the sureties shall affix their photographs and left thumb impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhaar card or bank pass book to ensure their identity.

[b] the petitioners shall report before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m., for a period of two weeks and thereafter, as and when required for interrogation.

[C] the petitioners shall deposit a sum of Rs.2,00,000/- (Rupees Two Lakhs only) in an interest accruing account in two installments to the credit of Cr.No.6 of 2024, on the file of the learned Judicial Magistrate No.I, Trichy, without prejudice to his contentions and rights before the trial Court. The petitioners shall pay the first installment of Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees One Lakh only) on or before 07.06.2024 and shall pay the second installment of Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees One Lakh only) on or before 02.08.2024. Failing which, the respondent police is at liberty to file a petition before this Court for cancellation of anticipatory bail.

[d] the petitioners shall not tamper with the evidence or witness either during investigation or trial.

[e] the petitioners shall not abscond either during investigation or trial.



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[f]On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioners in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioners are released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560].

[g]If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 229-A IPC.
