3.By consent of both parties, this Writ Petition is taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission itself.

4.It is submitted by the learned counsel for the 4th respondent and the learned counsel for the respondents 5 to 8 that the temple called 'Arulmigu Pattathu Mariamman Temple' at Anandhapuram is under the administration of the 4th respondent and the temple called 'Arulmigu Muthukan Mariamman Temple' at Nithyanandhapuram belongs to the private respondents, ie., respondents 5 to 8 and without consultation of either the 4th respondent or the trustees of the private temple, the petitioner has printed the invitation.

5.A perusal of the invitation shows that the festival would be performed for both the temples and the petitioner has filed this Writ Petition for some fictitious cause of action and therefore, the same is not maintainable. Accordingly, this Writ Petition is dismissed with exemplary cost of Rs.50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand Only) to the credit of High Court Legal Services Authority attached with this Bench on or before **07.06.2024**.
