PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Section 438 of Cr.P.C.

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.95 of 2024 on the file of the Respondent police.



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ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

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The petitioners, who apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 379 IPC and 21(4) of Mines and Mineral (Development and Regulations) Act in Crime No.95 of 2024 on the file of the respondent police, seek anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that the petitioners along with other accused have illegally transported six units of sand. Hence, the complaint.

3.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioners would submit that the petitioners are innocent and they have not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution and a false case has been foisted against them, hence they seek anticipatory bail.

4.The learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) appearing for the respondent police would submit that the petitioners have illegally transported six units of sand, hence he objected to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners. He further submits that the first petitioners are the owners of the vehicles used for illegal



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transportation.

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5.Taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners with certain conditions.

6.Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance, within a period of fifteen days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, before the learned Judicial Magistrate Court, Karaikudi, Sivagangai District, on condition that the petitioners shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/-(Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further conditions that:

[a]the petitioners and the sureties shall affix their photographs and left thumb impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhaar card or bank pass book to ensure their identity.

[b]the petitioners shall make a non refundable deposit of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand only), each to the credit of Madras High Court Madurai Bench Advocate Clerk's Welfare Association, Madurai in Indian Bank, Madras High



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Court Madurai Bench Branch, Account No.496039124 IFSC No.IDIB000H040, without
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prejudice to their contentions and rights before the trial Court and on such deposit
being made, the learned Judicial Magistrate shall accept the sureties furnished by the
petitioners;

[c]the petitioners shall report before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m.,
for a period of 30 days and thereafter, as and when required for interrogation.

[d]the petitioners shall not tamper with the evidence or witness either during
investigation or trial.

[e]the petitioners shall not abscond either during investigation or trial.

[f]On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court
is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioners in accordance with law as
if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioners are released on bail by the
learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court
in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560].



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[g]If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under
Section 229-A IPC.
