PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.25 of 2024 on the file of the Respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner, who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for



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the alleged offence punishable under Sections 109, 406, 420 and 120(b) IPC in Crime No.25 of 2024 on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that all the accused persons received a sum of Rs.4.50 Crores from the defacto complainant by promising that if he invested Rs.10 Crore in the iridium, it will fetch Rs.100 Crores in one year. Thereafter, they failed to act upon their promise. Hence, the case.

3.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is an innocent person and he has not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution. He further submits that during pendency of this petition, on the advice of the respective learned counsel, the parties amicably settled the issue.

4.The learned Government Advocate(Crl.side) appearing for the respondent Police submits that the investigation is yet to be completed.

5.Considering the above submission, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

6.Accordingly, this criminal original petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance, within a period of fifteen days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.II, Sivagangai on condition that the petitioner shall



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execute a bond for a sum of Rs.25,000/-(Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate No.II, Sivagangai and on further conditions that:

- i. The petitioner and the sureties shall submit a copy of their Aadhaar Card or any other identity card issued by the Government in proof of their residence address;
- ii. The petitioner shall appear before the respondent police on every Monday at 10.30 am until further orders. He has to co-operate for the investigation.
- iii. The petitioner shall not misuse the liberty granted to him by indulging in any further offence and shall not tamper with the prosecution witnesses.
The petitioner shall be available for the trial as well.
- iv. On violation of any of the above conditions by the petitioner, the respondent police shall move an application for cancellation of the anticipatory bail.
