PETITION FOR BAIL Under Sec.439 of Cr.P.C.

PRAYER :-

For Bail in Crime No. 170 of 2024 on the file of the Respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner / second accused, who was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 25.04.2024, for the offence under Sections 294(b) and 304 of IPC and in Crime No.170 of 2024 on the file of the respondent police, seeks bail.



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2. The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner assaulted the defacto complainant's father and he was declared dead. Hence, the complaint.

3. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is an innocent person and he has not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution. However, he is languishing in jail from 25.04.2024. Hence, he prays for grant of bail to the petitioner.

4. The learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) appearing for the respondent police submits that the investigation is yet to be completed.

5. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and also taking note of the period of incarceration, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

6. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of Judicial Magistrate Court No.II, Karur and on further conditions that :-

- a) the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the learned Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity.
- b) the petitioner shall report before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m, until further orders.



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- c) the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial.
- d) the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial.
- e) On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner is released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560].
- f) If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 229A IPC.
