PETITION FOR BAIL Under Sec.439 of Cr.P.C.

PRAYER :-

For Bail in Crime No.139 of 2024 on the file of the respondent police

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-



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The petitioner, who was arrested on 02.05.2024 for the alleged offence under Sections 406, 409, 411 and 420 IPC in Crime No.139 of 2024, on the file of the respondent police, seeks bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner along with the other accused hired the vehicle of the defacto complainant on rent and failed to return the same to the defacto complainant. Hence, the complaint.

3.It is now reported that the vehicle has been recovered from the accused and handed over to the owner of the vehicle.

4.In view of the above, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner with some conditions.

5. Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is ordered and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on the following conditions:-

i) The petitioner shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate No.I, Pudukkottai.

ii) The petitioner and the sureties shall submit a copy of their Aadhaar Card or any other identity card issued by the Government in proof of their residence address;



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iii) The petitioner shall report before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation.

iv) The petitioner shall not misuse the liberty granted to him by indulging in any further offence and shall not tamper with the prosecution witnesses. The petitioner shall be available for the trial as well.

v) On violation of any of the above conditions by the petitioner, the respondent police shall move an application for cancellation of the bail.
