PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.05 of 2024 on the file of the Respondent Police.



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ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

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The petitioner, apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent Police, in connection with a case in Crime No.05 of 2024, for the offence punishable under Sections 465, 467, 468 and 471 of IPC, has filed this petition seeking anticipatory bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner and other accused have tried to grab the defacto complainant's property. Hence, the case.

3. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is an innocent person and he has not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution. Hence, he prays for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

4. The learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) appearing for the respondent Police submits that the third and fourth accused have created forged documents and the same was cancelled by the Deputy Registrar concerned. However, as against the same, an appeal has been preferred before the Inspector General of Registration. He further submits that the third and fourth accused have already been granted anticipatory bail by the Court of Sessions concerned. The main overt act as against



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the petitioner is that he has stood as a witness in the document created by the second accused.

5. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and also considering the nature of offence, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

6. Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is ordered and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of his arrest or on his appearance within a period of fifteen days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, before the concerned learned Judicial Magistrate on condition that

(i) the petitioner shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand), with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate No.I, Tirunelveli District.

(ii) The petitioner and the sureties shall submit a copy of their Aadhaar Card or any other identity card issued by the government in proof of their residence address;

(iii) The petitioner shall appear before the respondent police daily at 10.30 am until further orders for interrogation. He has to co-operate for the investigation.



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(iv) The petitioner shall not misuse the liberty granted to him by indulging in any further offence and shall not tamper with the prosecution witnesses.

(v) On violation of any of the above conditions by the petitioner, the respondent police shall move an application for cancellation of the anticipatory bail.
