PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.146/2024 on the file of the Respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioners, who apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offence punishable under Sections 294(b), 324, 506(2) IPC in Crime No.146

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of 2024, on the file of the respondent police, seek anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that due to previous enmity with regard to the Pongal celebration, the accused persons assaulted the defacto complainant and also abused him with filthy language.

3.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are innocents and they did not commit any offence as alleged by the prosecution.

4.The learned Government Advocate(Crl.side) appearing for the respondent submits that the injured person has already been discharged from the hospital and there is no previous case pending as against the petitioners.

5.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and also considering the fact that the injured person has already been discharged from the hospital and that there is no previous case pending as against the petitioners, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

6.Accordingly, this criminal original petition is allowed and the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance, within a period of fifteen days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Thottiyam on condition that the petitioners shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.25,000/-(Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate, Thottiyam



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and on further conditions that:

- i. The petitioners and the sureties shall submit a copy of their Aadhaar Card or any other identity card issued by the Government in proof of their residence address;
- ii. The petitioners shall appear before the respondent police daily at 10.30 am., until further orders;
- iii. The petitioners shall not misuse the liberty granted to them by indulging in any further offence and shall not tamper with the prosecution witnesses. The petitioners shall be available for the trial as well.
- iv. On violation of any of the above conditions by the petitioners, the respondent police shall move an application for cancellation of the anticipatory bail.
