PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C.

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.173 of 2024 on the file of the Respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner, apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent Police, in connection with a case in Crime No.173 of 2024, for the offence under Sections 147, 294(b), 342, 323 and 506(ii) IPC, has filed this petition seeking anticipatory bail.

2. The petitioner herein is arrayed as A5. The case of the prosecution is that the

defacto complainant has borrowed a sum of Rs.1,15,000/- from A1 to A3, out of which, he has not repaid the balance amount of Rs.85,000/-. On account of that, when the defacto complainant went to his native village for temple festival, the accused persons went there and assaulted him with hands and also threatened him with dire consequences.

3. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is an innocent person and he has not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution. However, based on the confession statement of A1, the petitioner has been implicated in this case. Hence, he prays for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

4. The learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) opposes for grant of anticipatory bail on the ground that the investigation is yet to be completed. However, he fairly submits that A2, A3 and A4 have already been granted anticipatory bail by this Court in Crl.O.P.(MD)No.7636 of 2024.

5. Considering the nature of offence and also considering the fact that the petitioner has been implicated in this case only through the confession statement of A1 and some of the co-accused have already been granted anticipatory bail, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

6. Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is ordered and the petitioner is

ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance within a period of fifteen days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, before the learned Judicial Magistrate on condition that

(i) the petitioner executes a bond for a sum of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate, Vedaesendur, Dindigul District;

(ii) The petitioner and the sureties shall submit a copy of their Aadhaar Card or any other identity card issued by the government in proof of their residence address;

(iii) The petitioner shall appear before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m. until further orders. He has to co-operate for the investigation.

(iv) The petitioner shall not misuse the liberty granted to him by indulging in any further offence and shall not tamper with the prosecution witnesses.

(v) On violation of any of the above conditions by the petitioner, the respondent police shall move an application for cancellation of the anticipatory bail.
