PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.119/2024 on the file of the Respondent Police.



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ORDER: The Court made the following order :-

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The petitioners, apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent Police, in connection with a case in Crime No.119 of 2024, for the offence punishable under Sections 143, 294(b), 323, 324 and 506(ii) IPC, have filed this petition seeking anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that due to family dispute, on 31.05.2024, the accused have started to quarrel with the defacto complainant and others, attacked them using stick and caused injury. Hence the case.

3.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are innocent persons and they have not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution. Hence, he prays for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

4.The learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) appearing for the respondent Police submits that in this occurrence, four of them were injured, out of them, three persons were discharged from the hospital and one of the victims is still in hospital, for whom thirty stitches were put on his head. He further submits that the accused have caused serious injury.



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5. Considering the nature of injury and hospitalisation of one of the victims, this Court is not inclined to grant any relief to the petitioners. Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is dismissed for the present.
